COMMUNITY VOLUNTEER INCOME TAX PROGRAM 2018

Income tax returns completed by trained volunteers for individuals and families who qualify:

Single person	Up to \$30,000
Couple	Up to \$40,000
One adult, one child	Up to \$35,000
Each additional dependent	Up to \$2,500
Interest income less than	Up to \$1,000

- Clients should bring all their slips and if available, the Notice of Assessment from the previous tax year.
- Deceased persons (estates) cannot be completed.
- Clients who wish to file for a relative require documentation of Power of Attorney.
- Clients can file for 2017 and 2016 anytime. Clients who have 3 or more years to complete will have to book an appointment ahead of time.

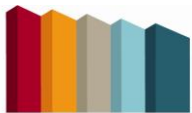
